



Materials Needed:

- A2 Chocolate scored cards--Yours Truly (6032241)
- 12" x 12" Orchestra patterned paper--7gypsies (6071947)
- 8 1/2" x 11" Fawn cardstock--Bazzill
- 8 1/2" x 11" Pomegranate cardstock--Bazzill
- Adage Tickets--Tim Holtz (6050607)
- Red glitter Lullaby Thickers--American Crafts(6060623)
- Black Glaze pen--Sakura (530777)
- Brown Le Pen--Marvy Uchida (6070962)
- 3mm silver metals--Mark Richards (6047415)
- 5mm silver domes--Mark Richards (6036226)
- Chestnut Roan chalk ink--ColorBox (513050)
- Beaded star metal--Vintaj (6072732)
- Stars altered blank metals--Vintaj (6072739)
- Metallic Mixatives alcohol ink--Ranger (7302)
- Blending solution--Ranger (522750)
- Glue pen
- Mini Glue Dots
- Dry adhesive, such as a tape runner

Instructions:

1. Adhere 5 1/4" x 4" patterned paper to brown card.
2. Adhere ticket strip across top of card and trim off excess.
3. Die-cut zig zag circle from Fawn cardstock and adhere to lower left corner of card.
4. Die-cut number "2" from red cardstock, draw faux stitching around perimeter of number, and adhere to card.
5. Add chipboard letters to spell "you".
6. Cut 1/2" strips of red cardstock. Write "Happy" and "Birthday" on each, ink edges using Chestnut Roan ink, and adhere to card.
7. Ink large metal star using silver ink and blending solution and allow to dry.

Suggested Tools

- Paper trimmer
- QuickKutz Epic Six or Sizzix Big Shot die-cutting machine
- Rick Rack circle dies--QuickKutz (6070370)
- Diesel alphabet dies--QuickKutz (6037689)
- Sanding block--Making Memories
- Alcohol ink handle--Ranger
- Scissors
- QuickStik or craft knife (optional)

Sand small metal star charm and adhere to card using Glue Dots.

Adhere large metal star to card using Glue Dots.

Add silver domes and silver metals, using a craft knife or QuickStik to assist you, if necessary.
