



#### Materials Needed:

- 8 1/2" x 11" white cardstock
- 8 1/2" x 11" brown cardstock--Bazzill
- 6" x 6" Joy Ride patterned paper stack--Cosmo Cricket (6070325)
- 12" x 12" Dear Lizzy&nbsp;Garden
- Gala&nbsp;fabric--American Crafts (6070578)
- Chestnut Roan chalk ink--ColorBox (513050)
- Tan burlap string--May Arts
- Brown burlap string--May Arts
- Brown Le Pen (6070962)
- 3mm clear gems--Mark Richards (6007729)
- Glue pen
- Pop Dots
- Dry adhesive, such as a tape runner

#### Suggested Tools

- QuickKutz Epic Six or Big Shot die-cutting machine
- Tim Holtz Caged Bird die--Sizzix (6070225)
- Tim Holtz Vintage Market Alphabet die--Sizzix (6070219)
- Tim Holtz Baroque die--Sizzix (6070231)
- Scissors
- Paper trimmer
- Scoring Tool (optional)
- QuickStik or craft knife (optional)

#### Instructions:

- Score and fold 5 1/2" x 11" white cardstock in half.
- Ink edges of 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" number patterned paper and adhere to card.
- Tear 1" off bottom of 5 1/4" x 5 1/4" teal patterned paper and ink edges.
- Adhere piece of brown string to upper left corner.
- Cut triangle pennants from fabric and adhere below string.
- Die-cut label from yellow cardstock, ink edges, and draw stitching around border using brown pen.
- Adhere label to right side of card and trim off excess.
- Die-cut sentiment and adhere to label.
- Wrap string around card and knot.
- Die-cut bird from brown cardstock and purple grid paper.
- Cut brown branch from bird and adhere to purple bird.
- Ink edges of bird and adhere to card using Pop Dots.
- Add gem to eye of bird, using a QuickStik or craft knife to assist you, if necessary.
