



Materials Needed:

- Ready-to-make frame--Creative Imaginations (6070057)
- Denim Paint Dabber--Ranger (6016689)
- 8 1/2" x 11" Parakeet cardstock--Bazzill
- 8 1/2" x 11" Hilary cardstock--Bazzill
- 8 1/2" x 11" Olive cardstock--Bazzill
- Mod Podge glossy clear coat (6002595)
- 12" x 12" Black Metallic Zig Zag patterned paper--Little Yellow Bicycle (6069584)
- 12" x 12" Striped Metallic Composite patterned paper--Little Yellow Bicycle (6069580)
- 12" x 12" turquoise check patterned paper--Little Yellow Bicycle (6069585)
- 12" x 12" orange & silver LIVE patterned paper--Little Yellow Bicycle (6069587)
- Royal Metallic Grid patterned paper--Little Yellow Bicycle (6069579)
- Delight Fabric chipboard Thickers--American Crafts (6061204)
- 4" x 12" adhesive metal sheets--QuicKutz (6056768)
- Charcoal chalk ink--ColorBox (513051)
- Dry adhesive, such as a nbsp;nbsp; tape runner

Instructions:

- Paint frame with denim paint and allow to dry.
- Cut patterned paper (use back sides of paper) to 2" x 2", ink with black ink, and adhere squares to frame.
- Die-cut dinosaur from green and brown cardstock. Die-cut circle for dinosaur and frame from three shades of green and metal paper.
- Ink green dinosaur using Charcoal ink.
- Adhere green circles to green dinosaur and cover with Rock Candy paint. Allow to dry.

Suggested Tools

- Exclusive dinosaur die--QuicKutz (6048390)
- QuicKutz Epic Six or Sizzix Big Shot die-cutting machine
- Paper trimmer
- Foam brush

The dinosaur will curl up after drying so adhere to brown cardstock to help flatten it out.
Adhere dinosaur to frame using Pop Dots. Spell name on frame using chipboard letters.
Adhere adhesive metal rings and circles to frame.
