



Materials Needed:

- 8 1/2" x 11" Cranberry cardstock
- 8 1/2" x 11" white cardstock
- 3/8" white satin ribbon--American Crafts (6076309)
- Forest Moss Distress Ink--Tim Holtz (6070089)
- Peeled Paint Distress Ink--Tim Holtz (526644)
- VersaMark ink (10334)
- Black Archival Ink (7380)
- Seafoam White embossing powder (7309)
- Dry adhesive, such as a tape runner

Instructions:

- Score and fold 8 1/2" x 5 1/2" red cardstock in half.
- Stamp tree four times at various heights on white cardstock using VersaMark ink and emboss with white embossing powder.
- Use the foam pad to rub Peeled Paint ink in a circular motion over the tallest tree.
- Use the foam pad to rub Forest Moss ink in a circular motion over the rest of the card, blending the two colors together.
- Use a damp paper towel to wipe away any ink left on top of the embossed trees.
- Let cardstock dry (increase dry time by using a heat tool).
- Stamp sentiment in upper right corner using black ink.
- Distress edges of cardstock using paper distresser.
- Wrap ribbon around bottom of cardstock and knot.
- Adhere inked cardstock to card.
