



Materials Needed:

- 8 1/2" x 11" Petal Soft cardstock--Bazzill
- 8 1/2" x 11" Guava Sensation cardstock
- 12" x 12" Ducks in Row patterned paper pack--October Afternoon
- 12" x 12" Pink Tutu cardstock--Core'dinations
- Crystal Stickles--Ranger
- Pink fabric Thickers--American Crafts (6061205)
- 2mm clear gems--Mark Richards (6007728)
- Mini Glue Dots
- Dry adhesive, such as a tape runner

Instructions:

- Score and fold 8 1/2" x 5 1/2" pink cardstock in half.
- Distress edge of 5 1/4" x 4" light pink cardstock and adhere to card.
- Punch two clouds from die-cut sheet (from paper pack) and adhere to card.
- Adhere 1 1/8" x 4" pink polka dot paper to left edge of card.
- Adhere fabric chipboard letters to pink polka dot paper.
- Using embossing mat and Epic Six machine, dry emboss butterfly on pink Core'dinations cardstock.
- Lightly sand top of the butterfly to make the lighter color show through.
- Cut out butterfly.
- Add Stickles to butterfly and allow to dry.
- Add small gems to butterfly, using a QuickStik or craft knife to assist you, if necessary.
- Adhere center of butterfly to card using Mini Glue Dots.
- Fold wings up to add dimension.
