



Materials Needed:

- VersaMark ink (10334)
- Charcoal Cat's Eye ink--ColorBox (513051)
- Medium gems--Mark Richards (6007729)
- Hazard cardstock--Bazzill (6033419)
- Luxe White A7 gatefold cards--Yours Truly (6036067)
- Tan burlap string--May Arts (6037375)
- 12" x 12" Bus Route patterned paper--October Afternoon (6074456)
- Black embossing powder--Inkadinkado (6075280)
- Dry adhesive, such as a tape runner

Instructions:

- Cut gatefold card in half to measure 3 1/5" x 5".
- Cut 5 1/2" circle from Hazard cardstock.
- Punch flower design near the edge. Adhere circle to front of card, allowing a small portion of the scallop to show.
- Trim the part of the circle that hangs over the edge. Be careful not to trim the folded part of card.
- Stamp and emboss sentiment above the punched circle.
- Add gem to center of flower.
- Cut a 1 1/2" x 5" piece of patterned paper. Ink edges and adhere to bottom inside of card.
- Tie string around front of card.
