



Materials Needed:

- Kraft notecards and envelopes (6070669)
- Black Tiny Type stickers--Cosmo Cricket (6069949)
- Black glitter Rockabye chipboard letters--American Crafts (6060619)
- Avignon chipboard numbers--7gypsies (6071939)
- 12" x 12" Avignon Decoration patterned paper--7gypsies (6071943)
- 12" x 12" Avignon Ecriture patterned paper--7gypsies (6071945)
- Vintage tags with numbers--7gypsies (6056371)
- Ephemera Gypsy die-cuts--7gypsies (6056367)
- Black burlap string--May Arts (6037374)
- Antique silver mini keys--7 Gypsies (6071909)
- Charcoal Cat's Eye ink--ColorBox (513051)
- Chestnut Roan Cat's Eye ink--ColorBox (513050)
- Clear gems--Mark Richards (6007728)
- Dry adhesive, such as a tape runner

Suggested Tools

- Trimmer
- Scissors
- Deco Scallop edge punch--EK Success (6070500)
- QuickStik or craft knife (optional)

Instructions:

- Cut orange pattern paper to 5 1/2" x 4 1/4". Ink edges using Chestnut Roan ink. Adhere to kraft card at an angle.
- Ink edges of finger tag using Charcoal ink. Adhere to card at an angle.
- Cut green patterned paper to 1 1/4" x 4 1/4". Use border punch to create deco edge. Ink edges using Charcoal ink. Adhere to left side of card.
- Ink edges of numbered die-cut using Chestnut Roan ink. Adhere to the right of the green strip.
- Lightly ink "40" using Charcoal ink. Adhere to card, just to the left of the finger.
- Add "th" stickers to the right of "40".
- Add "happy" chipboard letters.
- Wrap black string around card three times and tie a knot.
- Add three keys and tie an additional knot.

Add gems, using a craft knife or QuickStik to assist you, if necessary.
